<p>This term, your child will learn to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Communicate about their needs, wants, interests and opinions.</li> <li>• Begin to share experiences and play with children with similar interests.</li> <li>• Participate in group activities.</li> <li>• Initiate conversations and take account of what others say.</li> </ul>	<p>This term, your child will learn to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Understand and perform action words e.g., Jumping, following.</li> <li>• Follow a story with pictures or props.</li> <li>• Use vocabulary focused on objects and people of importance to them.</li> <li>• Continue a rhyming string</li> </ul>	<p>This term, your child will learn to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Move in a range of ways e.g., skipping, rolling, crawling.</li> <li>• Hold a pencil correctly with good control.</li> <li>• Catch a large ball.</li> <li>• Use one handed tools and equipment e.g., child scissors.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Research topics we are studying with your child, by visiting the library or going on the internet.</li> <li>• Bring in useful and relevant resources from home that we could use in the classroom.</li> <li>• Practise Jolly Phonics sounds and actions.</li> <li>• Read with your children regularly and encourage them to tell you what the story or book is about.</li> <li>• Do homework with your child and provide plenty of opportunities to draw and write.</li> </ul>

<p>This term, your child will learn to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Identify letters and sounds using the Jolly Phonics Classroom.</li> <li>• Use phonic knowledge to read and write simple words and begin to write some irregular common words.</li> </ul> <p>A selection of the texts we will be looking at are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Anansi the Spider</li> <li>• Super Milly and the Super School Day</li> <li>• Look up!</li> </ul>	<p>This term, your child will learn to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Say numbers in order and notice numerals (number symbols) around the classroom.</li> <li>• Recognise 2D shapes and make simple constructions using these shapes.</li> <li>• Explore the size, height and weight of objects.</li> </ul>	<p>This term, your child will learn to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Communicate their observations of their environment.</li> <li>• Talk about significant events they have experienced.</li> <li>• Discuss themselves and their family.</li> </ul>	<p>This term, your child will learn to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Sing songs, make music and dance.</li> <li>• Create a range of sounds through actions e.g., clapping, tapping, shaking.</li> <li>• Describe sounds and music e.g., Scary, funny.</li> </ul>

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
